Jackson Township will be hosting it's 14th annual **Jackson Heritage Festival on July 20-22, 2018** at Veterans Park in the village of Vinco. Vinco in Jackson Township is approximately 10 minutes from Johnstown, 45 minutes from Altoona and Somerset, 1 hour from Bedford and Greensburg, 1½ hours from Pittsburgh and State College and 2 ½ hours from Harrisburg. There are well over 500,000 people who live within 1 hour's drive of Jackson Township.

Last year the Heritage Festival proved to be an overwhelming success with thousands of people attending, with great food, top notch entertainment and fireworks! This years Festival will feature a full schedule of continuous entertainment alternating on two stages including **The House Band** (60's - Today's Music), **Tree** (Irish), **The Flood City Brass** (50's -80's Music), **Beavercreek** (Bluegrass) and the **Johnstown Buttonbox Club** (Polkas). There is additional entertainment that is yet to be announced at this time.

In addition there will be lots of **crafts and vendors**, a wide variety of **food** for everyone, **fireworks** on Saturday evening, childrens games and activities, a bounce tent, petting zoo, clowns, children's crafts, hayrides, miniature train display, bingo, kiddie competitions, car cruise-in, poker run, 5K race, cutest baby contest, pony rides and much more! In addition, there will be strolling entertainers such as **Spiderman** and **Unicycle Sam**!
